# ADDITIONAL THINGS TO SEE AND DO

## **Historic Fort Meigs, Perrysburg, Ohio**

Right in our own back yard is Fort Meigs. Fort Meigs, the largest reconstructed wooden-walled fort in the nation, was originally built to defend the Ohio country from British invasion during the War of 1812. Today the reconstructed fort and museum stand to tell the story of this pivotal time in America's history. The 65-acre park includes the full-size 10-acre replica of the 1813 fort. The museum exhibit *Legacy of Freedom: Fort Meigs and the War of 1812* focuses on the themes of era, conflict, understanding and remembrance. These sections place the War of 1812 into the context of the times and explain Fort Meigs' role in the conflict.

## **The River Raisin National Battlefield Park**

Continue your War of 1812 tour here. The area is the site of the costly Battle of Frenchtown, in which 397 Americans were killed and 547 taken prisoner after surrender to the British Army and Indian coalition. This United States National Park is located in the city of Monroe, Michigan. Approximately 25 minutes north of Toledo, it's easily accessed from the W.Britain World Headquarters.

## **The Henry Ford Museum**

Called "One of the country's best museums" you'll discover America - its culture, inventions, people and can-do spirit - and hundreds of hands-on ways to explore it, enjoy it and be inspired by it. Begun as Henry Ford's personal collection of historic objects, which he began collecting as far back as 1906, the site is a 12 acre collection of antique machinery, pop culture items, automobiles, locomotives, aircraft, and more! The Henry Ford, located in metro Detroit, is approximately one hour north of Toledo.

## **Greenfield Village**

This outdoor living history museum is adjacent to the Henry Ford Museum. Explore nearly one hundred historical buildings that were moved to the property from their original locations and arranged in a "village" setting. The Village is home to iconic buildings such as the Wright Brothers' Home & Cycle Shop, Thomas Edison's Menlo Laboratory, the Harvey Firestone Farm and much, much more.
